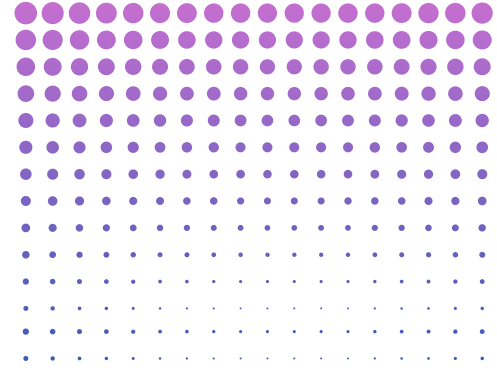

# Our Core Values

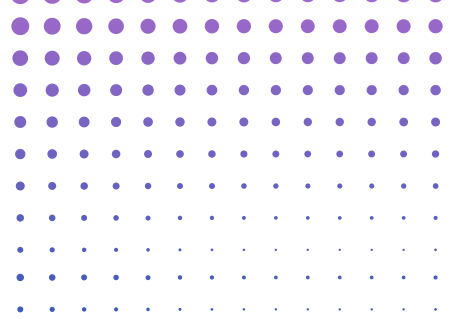

As a member of Boombox, we encourage you to embrace these values in every task, decision, and interaction. Let's build something great together!

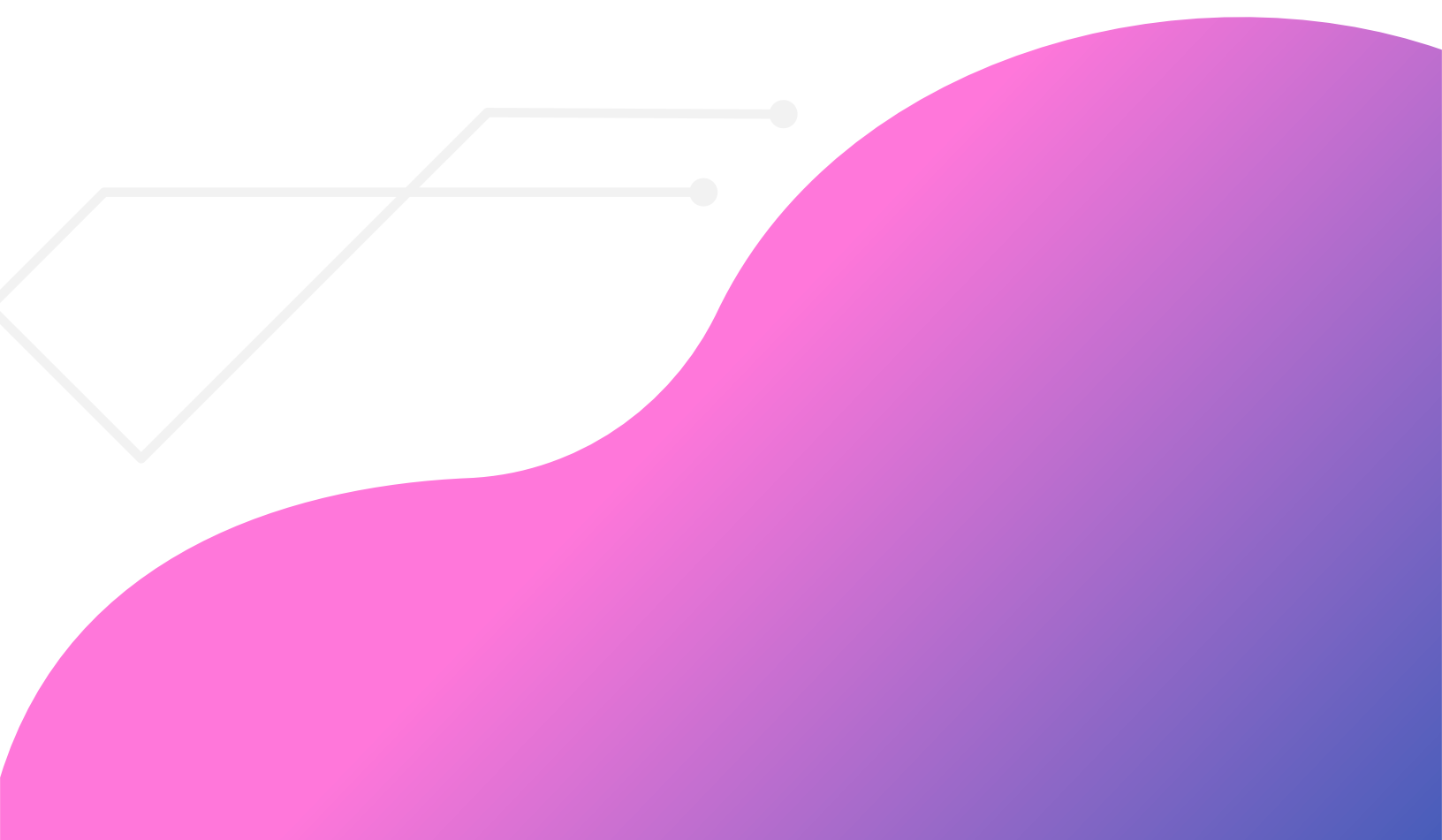




# Program Overview

The core summer season runs from May 11th to July 30th. There are sessions Monday–Thursday, which you will pick when you register. Each session will last 2 hours. We intentionally keep athlete numbers low per court so players receive more touches, more coaching interaction, and more individualized feedback.

Practices will be composed of roughly an hour of drills focused on specific skills with game like drills to end the practice.



# Attendance Policy

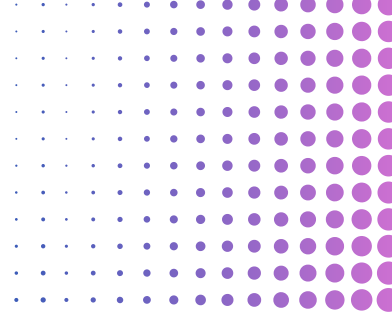
Consistency is essential for athlete development however we understand prior commitments and emergencies.

Because we staff courts carefully based on expected attendance:

- **Make-up practices are not guaranteed and are only allowed in exceptional circumstances. They must be approved by Rorianna Roth prior to the make-up session. They are based on coaching availability and court capacity.**

If a make-up practice has not been approved ahead of time, athletes may be asked to observe from the sidelines. This allows us to maintain safe court ratios and provide quality training.





# Director and Coach Responsibilities

## Coach

- Hold athletes to a high standard of effort and excellence

- Promote a culture of fun, discipline, competitiveness, and growth



# Athlete and Parent Responsibilities

# Sportsmanship Conduct

We are committed to creating a positive, respectful, and supportive environment for all athletes, coaches, referees, and spectators.

**We have a zero-tolerance policy. Unsportsmanlike conduct by parents, guardians, or spectators will not be tolerated.**

By registering your athlete and submitting payment, you acknowledge and agree to adhere to the following policies. **Failure to comply may result in a warning, suspension, or termination from the program without refund.**

Spectator Conduct Guidelines (per USAV, p1440, and FIVB rules):

- Do not call out instructions or coach from the sidelines during practices or games.
- Do not speak to or direct comments at the opposing team or its players.
- Do not address referees or officials at any time. Concerns may be directed privately to coaching staff after the match.

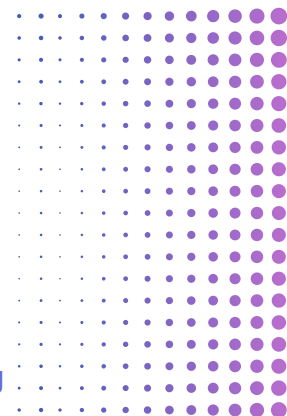
Practice Attendance:

- Parents/guardians should not attend or "drop in" on random practices unless previously authorized.
- Unplanned presence during practices disrupts coaching flow and distracts from athlete development, especially since coaching ratios are scheduled for specific group sizes.

Reffing Responsibilities:

- All families must ensure athletes fulfill their assigned reffing duties during events.
- Failure to do so may impact team standings and reflects poorly on our program.

Your cooperation is essential in helping us maintain a professional and athlete-focused environment. Thank you for your support and commitment to sportsmanship.



# Tournaments

Tournaments are widely available and easy to access! Participation in tournaments is optional—athletes and parents can choose which events they'd like to attend. Boombox will host several tournaments throughout the season, and we'll share details on how to register for out-of-town events during the parent meeting. Please note that tournament entry fees are not included in club dues. P1440 is the organization we host tournaments through. Information on out-of-town tournaments can be found on their website along with [volleyballife.com](http://volleyballife.com). While partners are not needed for practice, they are for tournaments. We can assist with finding partners if needed! If you are playing out of town and would like to bring a coach, please speak with Rorianna to find out how to hire one of our coaches. All players need to be P1440 for our program.

# Grievance Policy

If questions or clarification is requested about practice structure, coaching, games, etc, the **athlete** must first ask the coach at practice. We are building a culture of maturity and accountability!

For questions or concerns after the athlete has met with coaches individually, the next step is to message the director.

The Club Director (Rorianna) will decide if a phone call or in-person meeting is appropriate and ask the head coach from their court to attend that meeting. Directors will simply not meet with parents without a head coach and athlete present

There will be a 24hr. no contact period after a match / tournament where directors will not connect or meet with a parent about playing , positions, or other concerns.

Never talk poorly of officials, other teams, athletes, or coaches. Encourage your athlete and their teammate to the best of your ability. Be a supporter of TEAM!

# Payment Policy

The summer season costs \$600. All payments are due at the time of registration which will be done through Volleyball Life. The registration link is provided on the website.

The elite group will have an additional charge, charged through invoice. This is a tryout based group. More information will be provided at tryouts (April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026).

Payments will be non-refundable. Exceptions may be made in extreme circumstances.
